It may be in the familiar places you frequent. Or it may be in the places out of your comfort zone. The point is, we live in a world that is crying out for the beauty of Christ to restore it. And our feet are the feet Jesus has chosen to bring that beauty--equipped, guided, and directed by the Holy Spirit. We are HIs body. We are the beautiful feet. If we don't go, the world won't know. Calling all Sunday School classes, connect groups, and other small groups in the church!

The missions team is issuing a challenge to you for **Serve September**:

Host a service or outreach project in September as a group.

The core goal is to actively spread the good news about Jesus Christ through direct service and work performed by groups within the church.

- Month of July: Pray. Thoughtfully select a project and work out all the necessary details.
- Month of August: Pray. Post project description and a sign-up sheet to invite broader participation from the church. Reach out to people who don't attend Sunday School to join you.
- Month of September: Pray. Do your service project!
- Month of October: Pray. Evaluate your project. Send a brief report to the Missions Team, sharing glory sightings, challenges, and what you've learned.

What is the project? Who will you serve? That is completely up to you! You could choose a parachurch ministry, a neighborhood, a nonprofit organization, etc. Consider where your passions and giftings intersect with need and existing opportunities. Think about a gift of time and effort that stresses the importance of relationship-building or that positively impacts our immediate neighbors or ministry partners. The overall aim is for these projects to be life-giving and simple, allowing the smaller groups in our church to apply their strengths in the community as a means to share the love and good news of Jesus Christ with the world around us.
